SCHEDULE

3 Camels

CONDITIONS SUBJECT TO WHICH THE LICENCE IS GRANTED

1. The animals shall at all times be, kept by Moira Gould and Alastair Fraser of 10 Orchard Farm Close, Sedbury, Chepstow, Monmouthshire. NP16 7BG.
2. Only 3 animals of the species shall be kept on the premises, i.e. 3 Camels.
3. The animals shall only be moved from the premises for trekking/promotional activities within the Forest of Dean District Council's area.
4. Where the camels are to be taken outside the Forest of Dean District Council's area for a period exceeding 72 hours the Licensee must notify the Forest of Dean District Council.
5. The animals shall at all times be kept in accommodation which secures that the animal will not escape, which is suitable as regards construction, size, temperature, lighting, ventilation, drainage and cleanliness and which is suitable for the number of animals proposed to be held in the accommodation.
6. The camels shall not be kept in the field adjacent the public footpath until such time as suitable stock proof fencing has been erected.
7. The animals shall be supplied with adequate and suitable food, drink and bedding material and be visited at suitable intervals.
8. Accommodation shall be such that the animals can take adequate exercise.
9. Appropriate steps shall at all times be taken for the protection of the animals and the public in case of fire or other emergency. A suitable fire extinguisher, which has been serviced by a competent person within the last 12 months should be readily available at the camel shelter.
10. All reasonable precautions shall be taken at all times to prevent and control the spread of infectious diseases.
11. The Licensees shall hold a current policy of insurance, which insures them and all persons against liability for any damage, which may be caused by the animal(s).
12. The Licensee shall at all reasonable times make available a copy of the licence to any person, specified by the District Council.
